

DISCIPLINARY COMPLAINT RESOLUTION AGREEMENT

pursuant to section 55(2)(a.1) of the *Health Professions Act*

BETWEEN:

TASHA BRYENTON, #101,870
(the “**Registrant**”)

and

College and Association of Registered Nurses of Alberta
also known as **College of Registered Nurses of Alberta**
(the “**College**”)

A Disciplinary Complaint Resolution Agreement (“**DCRA**”) was executed between the Registrant and the College, dated with effect **August 30, 2023**. The below constitutes a summary of such DCRA:

Through a DCRA with the College, TASHA BRYENTON, #101,870 (the “**Registrant**”), acknowledged and admitted that their behaviour constituted unprofessional conduct. Particulars of the Registrant’s unprofessional conduct arises from one (1) complaint to the College include the following:

- Between approximately November 1, 2020, and February 11, 2021, the Registrant failed to practice with honesty, integrity and respect, when they diverted in excess of 12,000 milligrams of narcotics and controlled drugs including diazepam, and hydromorphone from their employer for their personal use;
- Between approximately November 1, 2020, and February 11, 2021, the Registrant failed to adequately assess their fitness to practice and demonstrate adequate judgment when, on numerous occasions, they attended work while unfit to practice; and
- Between approximately November 1, 2020, and February 11, 2021, the Registrant failed to accurately document patient care and failed to uphold medication management standards, when they failed to accurately account for narcotics and/or controlled drugs through wastage records, patient orders and drug administration records.

The Registrant agreed to complete course work on medication management and professionalism and provide a letter from a physician. The Registrant further agreed to pay a fine, provide practice report letters covering 660 hours of practice, and provide ongoing employer notifications for two (2) years. Conditions shall appear on the College register and on the Registrant’s practice permit.
