

DISCIPLINARY COMPLAINT RESOLUTION AGREEMENT

pursuant to section 55(2)(a.1) of the *Health Professions Act*

BETWEEN:

AARON ALIGOUR, #95,793
(the “**Registrant**”)

and

College of Registered Nurses of Alberta
(the “**College**”)

A Disciplinary Complaint Resolution Agreement (“**DCRA**”) was executed between the Registrant and the College, dated with effect March 26, 2024. The below constitutes a summary of such DCRA:

Through an Agreement with the College, Aaron Aligour, #95,793 (the “**Registrant**”), acknowledged and admitted that their behaviour constituted unprofessional conduct. Particulars of the Registrant’s unprofessional conduct arises from one (1) complaint to the College include the following:

- On or around May 15, 2023 to September 18, 2023, the Registrant, while working as an RN, failed to demonstrate honesty, integrity and ethical conduct by failing to report alternate employment in the role of a Registered Nurse and functional ability levels to their employer’s insurance provider from May 15, 2023 to September 18, 2023 and consequently improperly received short term disability benefits.

The Registrant agreed to complete coursework, pay a fine and provide employer notifications for two (2) years. Conditions shall appear on the College register and on the Registrant’s practice permit.
